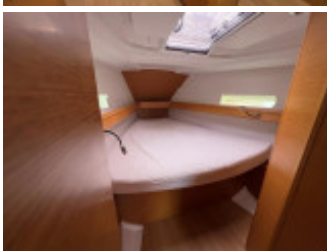
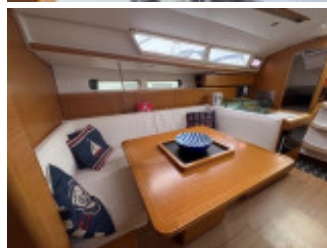

The Jeanneau Sun Odyssey 409 is a 40-foot sailboat designed by Philippe Briand, known for its speed, stability, and comfortable interior. Cerigo II benefits from recent saildrive replacement, updated electronics, set of performance sails and heating. She has been well looked after throughout her current ownership.

Constuction

The Jeanneau Sun Odyssey 409 features a hand-laid solid fiberglass hull with a protective barrier coat and ISO gelcoat. The deck is constructed using the Prisma process, an injection molding technique, with a balsa core. The boat also incorporates a 3rd generation fiberglass inner grid for added strength. **Hull Construction** The hull is constructed from hand-laid fiberglass, ensuring a strong and durable structure. ISO Gelcoat A high-quality gelcoat, meeting ISO standards is used for the outer layer providing protection and a smooth finish. A barrier coat is applied to further protect the hull from osmosis and water ingress. Fiberglass inner grid provides structural reinforcement and is a key feature in Jeanneau's construction. **Deck Construction** The deck is built using the Prisma process, which involves injecting resin into a mold, resulting in a strong, lightweight, and consistent structure. Discontinuous balsa core is used in the deck to add stiffness and insulation while keeping weight down. **Keel Type:** The Cerigo II is

equipped with a fixed L-shaped deep draft 2.1m fin keel. **Rudder Type** It features a fiberglass rudder with a spade-type design. **Interior** The interior features wood trim and traditional woodwork, offering a comfortable and inviting space. Seacocks professionally checked and replaced as necessary (2024)

Accommodation

The Jeanneau Sun Odyssey 409 typically offers accommodation for up to 8 people, with 3 double cabins and a convertible saloon berth. It includes two heads (toilets with showers), and the main cabin's heads has a separate shower area. The galley is equipped with a double sink, fridge with freezer compartment and a twin-burner cooker with an oven and grill. **Cabins.** The boat features three double cabins, each with a double berth, providing sleeping space for six. **Saloon.** The main saloon's settee and table can be converted into an additional double berth, increasing the sleeping capacity to eight. **Heads.** There are two toilet/shower rooms (heads) on board. both with grey holding tanks. The main cabin's head include has a separate shower area with a folding screen. **Galley.** The galley is well-equipped for meal preparation, with a double sink, a top-entry fridge with freezer compartment, a twin-burner cooker, oven and grill, Microwave and ample storage. **Other Amenities.** Each cabin typically has a hanging wardrobe, and the cockpit may feature teak seats, a large fixed table with folding leafs, internal and external speakers connected to the CD/radio and hot and cold cockpit shower on close to aft platform. **Heating.** Webasto warm air heating with 4 outlets (serviced 2023) **Saloon Upholstery.** White leatherette **Woodwork,** Alpi teak with matte finish
